VI. Selected Special Invitations

I have received several invitations to present overviews of the U.S. dairy industry and dairy policy over time. During the review period I presented such information to two Cochran Fellows-sponsored groups from Ecuador and Peru [CV D33] and Kosovo [CV D43]. In both cases, the policy and trade elements of the U.S. industry were of particular interest.

The Dairy Industry Advisory Committee (DIAC) was named by the Secretary of Agriculture in January 2010 to provide him with advice on dairy issues and recommendations for upcoming dairy policy discussions. Members from all segments of the dairy industry were included on the committee. In February of 2010 I was invited to make a presentation [CV D39] at the first meeting of the group on milk utilization patterns in the United States.

Invitations to give presentation at the Invitational Workshop for Dairy Economists and Policy Analysts sponsored by the dairy markets and Policy extension Education Committee (Cornell and Texas A&M) have also been extended to me over time. The workshop draws economist and policy analysts from industry, academia and government annually for discussions of current dairy market and policy topics. The most recent presentation was in 2009 on U.S. dairy trade[CV D36].

VII. Selected Special Assignments

Beginning in 2006 I was assigned to assist in updating the Regional Environment and Agriculture Programming (REAP) model housed in ERS's RRED for its use in estimating the effects on agriculture of increased biofuel demand. My work involved updating livestock production cost components of the REAP model to the most

current estimates. In the case of beef cow-calf operations, I had to develop an updating procedure to bring forward survey data from the 1980s, the only survey data available at that time. Data from dairy, hogs and poultry was available from much more recent surveys for 2005. Because survey designs had changed, I also defined a “concordance” to align the REAP and commodity survey cost categories. Using estimates derived from REAP and other modeling efforts using FAPSIM (the ERS model used for long term “baseline” projections), I contributed to the analysis requested by Sen. Saxby Chambliss in 2007 prepared by ERS and the Office of the Chief Economist [CV C33]. The ERS analysts that worked on that report, including myself, were awarded the ERS Helios Award for Research and Staff Analysis in April of 2009.

Staff analyses have been an integral part of my activities during my career at ERS. During the review period, from May 2006 to the present, I contributed to approximately 20 staff analyses from a range of requesters including USDA administrative personnel, Congressional members and staffs, and research groups. These analyses most often related to dairy issues on a wide range of questions—from simple statistics to expected impacts of dairy policy or program changes.

VII. Other Significant Information
